

Final Podcast/ Twitch Livestream

This assignment integrates the multiple literacies we've practiced over the course of the semester: written, verbal, digital, visual.

Podcast/Twitch Livestream Requirements:

1. Record, edit, and produce your podcast using software such as Audacity or Garageband, and then upload your episode to soundcloud.com. Alternatively, you can create a Twitch Livestream and upload the link.
2. Your podcast / twitch stream should be 8-12 minutes in length.
3. The introduction to your podcast/twitch should provide relevant information, establish a clear purpose, and immediately engage the audience.
4. The content of your podcast/twitch should be original and creative, focused on a relevant topic to the course and supported by accurate and adequately researched information (3 sources, at least 1 being an academic article).
5. Your podcast/twitch should answer the following questions:
 - a. Does your episode follow a coherent and compelling narrative arc?
 - b. Do you reflect on an equity issue in Technology?
6. Your spoken delivery should be well rehearsed, expressive, and briskly paced to maintain the audience's attention and interest.
7. Make sure that your words are clearly enunciated and that your grammar is correct. In terms of production, smooth out transitions to eliminate dead space.
8. Your cover art should be representative of your podcast/twitch topic.

Stretch Challenges

- Music and audio cues should be strategically placed to enhance the podcast's /twitch content.
- Include at least one interview in your podcast/twitch stream

Deliverable:

- The podcast will be graded using the [Digital Artifact rubric](#). Should be between 8-12 minutes in length. You must have an average score of 2 (Level 2) to pass this assignment.
- Link to practice podcast in SoundCloud or Twitch Livestream due into **Gradescope by July 30th**

Present your Podcast/Twitch Stream in Class on July 30th:

5 min presentation: Promo clip of podcast/twitch stream

- Play 30-60 seconds of audio of the podcast/twitch clip
- Showcase your artwork
- Brief outline of the podcast/twitch stream
- Discuss what you are most proud of
- Discuss your biggest challenge and how you overcame it
- Outline any future directions you would want to take the podcast/twitch stream
