1. Living Room

A sofa is one of the most important furniture purchases for your home, so before you buy a sofa make sure you are getting one that fits your needs. Chances are you and your family spend a lot of time around the dining table doing different tasks such as homework, paying bills, or even sitting down and chatting. The kind of dining chair you buy depends on many things such as the size of your room, how you use it, your style, etc.

3. Bedroom

6. Curtains

9. Rugs
