
Creating Resources with *Diff*it


Create Resources:

- 1. Head to web.diffit.me.
- 2. Click "Teachers Start Here" and "Sign In" at the top right and sign in with Google.
- Using the "Literally Anything" tab, choose a Topic and Grade Level for the material then click on "Generate Resources".







4. You will have a resource created with a reading selection, vocabulary, multiple styles of quiz questions, and more. Click on the green "Get Student Activities" button.




5. Scroll through and choose the type of resource you want to create to share with your students. Some of these activities will be "Subscription Only" like creating Google Forms, but many will be free.



6. You will have the option of how to share this resource. The Free version will allow you to save this as a PDF.



7. Even with this limitation, all you have to do is edit the original in any of the text/editing areas.



8. Share and enjoy your customized resources! To see all your created resources, head to the *My Resources*" tab at the top.
