



6TH GRADE CLASSROOM MATERIALS

This is a list of supplies students will use throughout the school year. Students should have these materials on the first day of school, and each should be clearly marked with their name (first and last).

Materials Students Need

- Binders
 - 2 - 1-inch binder for health and foreign language (or bigger for French & Spanish)
 - 3 - 1.5-inch binder for math, science, and social studies
 - 1 - 2-pocket folder for English
- Dividers
 - 5 sets of dividers for binders (5-tabs)
- Writing Utensils
 - #2 pencils, traditional or mechanical
 - Blue and black ink pens
 - 2-3 highlighters of different colors
 - 1 pack of 5 or more black dry erase markers (**for Spanish, French, & Chinese**)
 - Pencil bag or box
 - 1 packet of erasers
- Math Supplies
 - 12-inch ruler, displaying both centimeters and inches
 - 1 protractor
 - 1 packet - graph paper
 - 2 2-pocket folders
 - For students in Math 6 and Pre-Algebra 6: Scientific calculator: **Texas Instruments TI-30X IIS** is highly recommended for students in Math 6 and Pre-Algebra 6
 - For students in Algebra or Geometry courses: Graphing calculator: **TI 83 Plus, TI 84, or TI 84 Plus** are recommended models by Texas Instruments. Note: *The "Plus" models have more memory. Any of these calculators can be used through calculus.*
- Misc.
 - 1 package of Post-It Notes
 - 1 glue stick
 - 1 pair scissors



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- 1 accordion folder for homework with at least 6 pockets
 - 1 3-subject spiral-bound notebook for English
 - 3 packages of lined wide or college ruled loose leaf paper
 - 1 computer headphones with a microphone for recording (**Chinese only**)
 - 1 pack of markers
 - 1 pack of colored pencils
 - If you have a device with a built-in microphone to do online recording, you do not need this.

- Be sure to label all materials with student's first and last name.
