



Canoe Kayak Ontario (CKO) Sprint's Ontario Cup – Ontario Summer Games Information & Registration Package

Event: Ontario Cup – Ontario Summer Games
Dates: July 30 - August 1, 2026
Competition Venue: Guelph Lake Park - 7743 Conservation Road, Guelph, Ontario
Athlete's Village: Wilfrid Laurier University, Waterloo, Ontario
Purpose: The competition objectives are to provide a multi-provincial Games experience for top U16 and Special Olympics athletes and coaches from across Ontario.

Competition Specifics

The competition format will include U16, and Special Olympics events.

Qualification Process: The Top 5 ranked U16 athletes in MK, WK, WC, MC from each Division based on 2026 Ontario Team Trials results. The next 7 U16 MK, WK, WC, MC athletes and Top 6 Special Olympics (total of 12 athletes & sport assistants) nominations from each Division are based on Divisional criteria.

Number of Events: Each athlete must compete in at least two events and a maximum of eight events.

To participate, all entrants must be registered with a Canoe Kayak Canada (CKC) member club for the 2026 season in either the Eastern Ontario Division (EOD) or Western Ontario Division (WOD) and must be in "good standing" with the Canoe Kayak Ontario (CKO) Sprint and their member club.

All payments for any outstanding accounts to CKO Sprint must be made in advance of the Competition Meeting prior to the event. This applies to clubs, coaches, and competitors.

Divisions will be invoiced for their registration fees and all other related fees post competition. Payment is due 30 days from the invoice day, after which a past due payment fee of 2% per 30-day period will be applied.

Athletes will compete for their respective Divisions. They will travel to the Games based on a prearranged Divisional transportation plan. Athletes, Sport Assistants, Coaches, and Managers will be provided food and accommodation from Thursday, July 30th to Saturday, August 1st, 2026. While at the Games, participants will take part in the Opening Ceremony and will have the opportunity to watch other sports competing at the Games.

Participant Games Registration

All Games participants (athletes, sport assistants, coaches, managers, Officials, and PSO reps) must register through the Games system. Only those registered by the deadline can participate in the Games. It is highly recommended that all athletes attending a Divisional qualifying event register for the Games.

Entries are to be submitted to ryan@ckosprint.ca, using the following [entry form](#), by Tuesday, July 21, 2026. A draft draw will be produced by Friday, July 24, 2026. All name changes and/or scratches will be made individually by each Divisional representative directly on the Google Drive. All changes must be made before the Competition Meeting. After which, all name changes and scratches must be submitted directly to the Competition Secretary/Manager, using our online [Change Form](#).

The Games entry fees for the 2026 Ontario Cup – Ontario Summer Games is \$125 for each athlete and sport assistant. Divisions will charge additional fees to cover travel, gear, and other related expenses.

The competition will be run using modified Canoe Kayak Canada's (CKC) Sprint Racing Discipline Competition Rules. There will not be boat weighing for all events. A copy of the Sprint Racing Discipline rules can be found [here](#). Modified rules will be reviewed with the coaches at the Competition Meeting.

Supervised on-water training will be available between 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm on Thursday, as well as 30 minutes before the first race each day.

Boat Numbers: CKO Sprint will NOT be responsible for providing boat numbers. Participating Divisions and athletes will be responsible for providing their own regulation size boat numbers.
