Continuing Education Guide

Note from Joy Myong:

Everyone who completes my Phase 1 and Phase 2 Brainspotting training will receive a free Attendance Certificate for 21 contact hours. Some states accept this to renew license, but most do not. The paid CE's handled by **Engaged Minds Continuing Education** are specifically for LPC's and /MFT's who work in states that require a sponsored NBCC accredited Completion Certificate. If this applies to you, go ahead and register using the payment link at the bottom of the welcome email by Friday (Day 2 of the training.)

Yes CE requirements can be a bit confusing. Joy will answer your questions on Day 1 of training.

Instructions from **Engaged Minds/Continuing Education**:

Within 3 days after the event, you will receive access to your evaluation and continuing education certificate via a personalized attendee dashboard link. This link will be sent to the email account you used to purchase/register for Continuing Education credits/hours. Please complete the course evaluation within 30 days of the class. You must attend the entire class to be able to receive CEs. Partial credit is not allowed.

Again, you must sign up for Continuing Education Credits/Hours before or during the live workshop. CEs will not be offered for purchase after the event is over. Within 3 days after the event, you will receive access to your evaluation and continuing education certificate via a personalized attendee dashboard link, hosted on the CE-Go website. This link will be sent to the email account you used to purchase/register for Continuing Education Credits/Hours. Please complete the course evaluation within 30 days of the class. You must attend the entire class to be able to receive CEs. Partial credit is not allowed.
