The entry fee consists of an organizing fee of 100€/person and wind tunnel time. If competitor competes in more than one discipline the organizing fee is paid only once ie. entry fee of additional disciplines will be only tunnel time. The organizing fee of 100€ is non-refundable.

It is possible to compete in multiple disciplines. By registering to multiple disciplines, the competitor accepts that it might not be possible to provide full requisite intervals as stated in rules between competition performances.

Late registration fee is 100€/team. Late registrations are possible until March 20th 12:00PM.

RULES

FAI SPORTING CODE

In addition: specific exceptions and refinements to FAI rules accepted by Skydiving Committee / FAA. If there are any updates to the FAI rules Fööni Open is following them.

Exception to rules: The tunnel staff may need to work in the tunnel during competition. This flying will not be considered as training.

The competitors won't need the FAI-licence to compete. The license is though recommended in case of possible records in the official FAI disciplines.

TRAINING ROUNDS AND SPEED SETTINGS

Speed settings for Solo Freestyle, D2W and D4W -participant: two (2) minutes. Other disciplines are one (1) minute.

No official training rounds. Pre-competition training time for all registered participants in all the categories can be booked from Fööni reception and flown until Friday 21.3.25 13:00pm.

OFFICIAL TRAINING VIDEOS

It is possible to test judging and send judges a training video/videos from prior training. The judges will judge these training routines for each discipline instead of official training rounds. See instructions for video delivery below.

FREE ROUTINE VIDEOS (FREESTYLE, D2W) AND ADDENUM D

As stated in rules the teams competing in these disciplines must deliver a video of their Free Routine(s) to the Chief Judge at least two (2) days in advance (48 hours) before the start of the competition. The video must be uploaded as is described later in this document. Competitors are responsible for the quality of the video delivered. As stated in rules, certain things need to be declared to judges before the start of the competition. A standard form, addendum D is the recommended mode to do this.

DELIVERING THE MATERIAL

All material (training videos and freestyle free routines, free routine music in mp3 or wav) must be delivered via WeTransfer (no login needed).

- Write to message team/competitors name, discipline and specify what the file is (example: *freestyle_my-name_music.mp3*, or *freestyle_my-name_freeroutine.mov*)

- Addendum D as an attachment to events@lentotehdas.fi
- All files need to be named with team name and explanation which file (ie D2W team xx Free routine, or D2W team xx Free routine music)
- All material must reach the organizer no later than Wednesday 20.3.2024 10:00 am.

Fööni can provide transmitter receivers to borrow for free routine music for Solo Freestyle and D2W. Own earphones (8mm plug) are recommended but Fööni can also provide earphones to borrow.

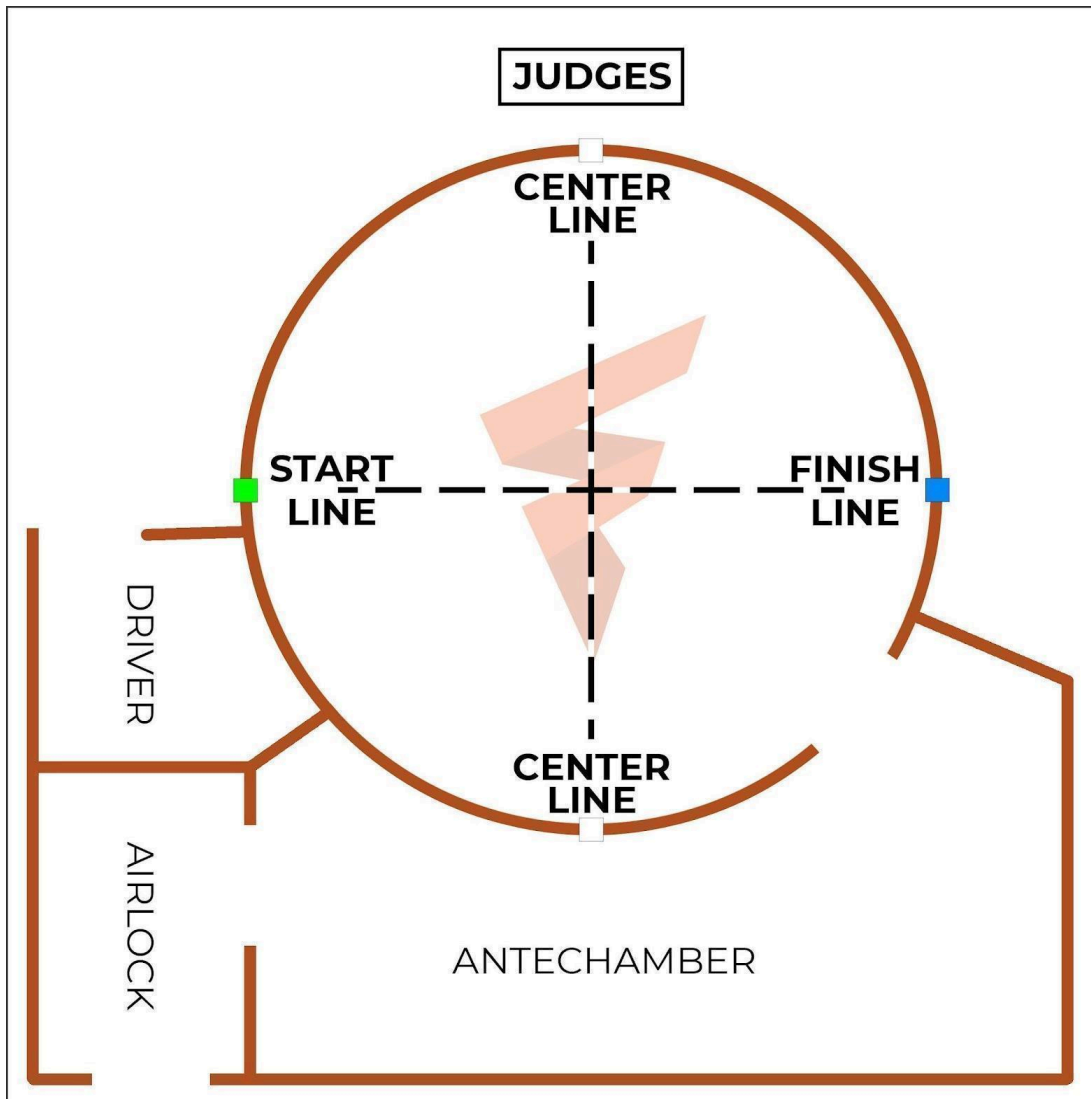

DATA PROTECTION

By registering for the competition, you agree that your name will be published on the start and result list unless specifically prohibited (GDPR), and in addition, entry and result information may be published for example for media use and statistics.

The information can be published freely, for example by the organizer of the competition, the Finnish Aeronautical Association (FAA) and the International Aviation Association FAI, as well as the Finnish Olympic Committee.

Result data is retained indefinitely. Other personal information collected during registration will be kept for as long as necessary.

Entrants have the right to restrict the use of their information and competitors will be asked to indicate any restrictions on their personal information when registering. Restricting information may prevent access to competitions.
