- Romans, 1 & 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 & 2 Thessalonians, 1 & 2 Timothy, Titus, and Philemon.
- Some attribute Hebrews to Paul, but there is not compelling evidence he wrote that book.

Paul uses the word \_\_\_\_\_ 60 times in his letters.

Greek word for gospel = Euangelion

- Eu = \_\_\_\_\_ or well
- Anglos = \_\_\_\_\_ or messenger

Paul uses the word \_\_\_\_\_ 74 times in his letters.

Greek word for sin = Hamartia

- Means to \_\_\_\_\_
- Hebrew word means to \_\_\_\_\_.

Two categories of sin:

1. Omission = things we \_\_\_\_\_ do that we should do.
2. Commission = things we \_\_\_\_\_ that we should not do.

Either way it is a conscious recognition that we are doing something that \_\_\_\_\_ God and working to change it.

Where have you, in your life, strayed from the path?
