Quick Summary

MarchOnHarrisburg is challenging 102+ representatives to bypass Majority Leader Benninghoff, who has failed to call the Gift Ban up for a floor vote for multiple sessions, and force a vote on the bill by forming a #MajorityAgainstCorruption. We need volunteers to contact their representatives and let them know about our campaign. Then on September 12, they will have the ability to make this a reality. We're asking volunteers to help pressure their local representatives to be BOLD and pass this legislation that many of them tell us they support in lobbying meetings. We're giving them the opportunity to show us they mean it in September, and we want them to be on notice!

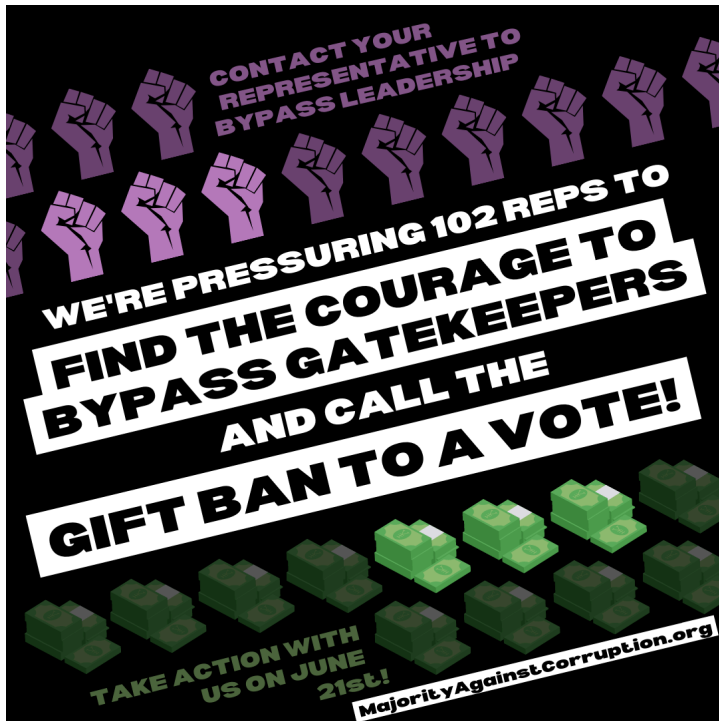

Every session, more than 4,000 bills are introduced. ONE committee chair and ONE majority leader, in the House and Senate, have the power to block any legislation, no matter how popular it is with Pennsylvanians. The result is that in the 2019-2020 PA Legislative Session, over 86% of the 4,199 bills introduced never even made it to the chamber floor for a first reading.
