Track and Field

The 2013 Brophy Track and Field season all came together with the Arizona Championship Team title at the Division 1 state meet with 85 points. Among the many members of the team who contributed to the AZ State Championship finish were individual point scorers Devon Allen, Bobby Grant, Cole Walsh, Jack Rubenzer, and Marco Ruiz, along with state scoring relay team members Dalton Radcliffe, D'Amani Grayer, Robert Relf, Clarence Clark, Isaiah Oliver, Ben Sacks, and Ryan Opila.

Senior Devon Allen scored 38 individual points winning the 110m High Hurdles, 300 Intermediate Hurdles, and the 200m, plus he placed 2nd in the 100m. Devon now holds the all-time Arizona High School track records in the 110m High Hurdles (13.48) and the 300m Intermediate Hurdles (36.39). He holds the Brophy School records for the 200m (20.75), 100m (10.49) and Decathlon 6478 points. Senior Cole Walsh scored 8 points at state with 2nd place in the pole vault, he set our Brophy school record clearing 16'9". Junior Bobby Grant placed 2nd at state in the 300m IH with the Arizona #2 all-time record time of 36.88 (US # 2 junior), he placed 3rd in the 200m, 6th in the 110m HH, and he was on the 2nd place 4x400m relay team with Isaiah Oliver, Dalton Radcliffe, and Jack Rubenzer. Senior Jack Rubenzer placed 5th in the 800m, Jack is our Brophy school record holder in the 800m (1:53.8). Senior Marco Ruiz placed 5th in the 3200m (9:29.5) and was the 4x800m relay that placed 5th at state with Ryan Opila, Ben Sacks, and Jack Rubenzer. The Brophy 4x100 relay group with seniors Dalton Radcliffe, Robert Relf, Clarence Clark and D'Amani placed 5th at state.

The 2013 season featured many great performances as we traveled to meet the best high school competition in the southwestern US. The Brophy varsity 4x400m relay record was set in 2013 with the #6 all- time Arizona time of 3:16.82 by Bobby Grant, Devon Allen, Jack Rubenzer and Isaiah Oliver at the Mt SAC relays in California. Pole vaulter Cole Walsh and hurdler Devon Allen were champions at the nationally contested Arcadia CA Invitational this season along with the hurdle shuttle relay team of Devon Allen, Bobby Grant, Isaiah Oliver and Dalton Radcliffe. Junior Bobby Grant won the 300m hurdle championship at the huge Arizona Chandler Rotary Invitational and he won the 400m at the Arizona Meet of Champions. Devon Allen, Bobby Grant and Cole Walsh were champions in their events at the Golden West Invitational in San Francisco.

The best high school track in Arizona - our Brophy Sports Complex Track, had many of its'stadium records set at our three big invitationals hosted by Brophy. It was the third year for the AMDG Invite in early March, the second for the Fr. Harry 'Dutch' Olivier Invitational in April, and the second time hosting the Arizona Meet of Champions after state in May. Many of the top 2013 Arizona high school track and field performances took place here and more than 20 of our BSC stadium records were reset with impressive times and distances that may be on the record board for many years.

Brophy track and field 2013 continued in June with several individuals competing in prestigious meets around the United States including the Golden West Invitational, USA Youth Championships, and the USA Junior World trials .

The spring 2014 track and field season looks great for the Brophy Broncos. The many veteran Brophy track coaches including Bill Kalkman, Mike Keahon, Tim O'Neil, Joe Klein, Doug Cox, Chris Ramsey, Muhammad Oliver, Ted Skowron, Alex Mason, Matt Williams, and, all who each specialize in certain track and field events, will have their athletes well prepared. With more than 100 underclassmen returning for another spring season on the track at the Brophy Sports Campus, Brophy track will continue to record outstanding performances and be a team that brings a diverse group of Brophy students together.
