Artist Statement

My recent series of works, titled *The Between*, represents my view of the world.

For me, the word **Between** holds two meanings: Yin and Yang, the invisible and the visible. It refers to an immense yet unseen reality that, although not physically manifested, connects life's

stories—providing them with structure and meaning. I am deeply fascinated by the idea that every event, even when it seems coincidental, has a significant cause in our lives. Just as we perceive the presence of wind by watching tree branches sway, we can recognize an invisible reality through what is visible to us.

This concept aligns with the idea of **Between the Lines**. Some phenomena do not physically exist yet appear to us as suggested images, such as the horizon. These various in-between phenomena must be part of a reality beyond our direct perception.

My works seek to express this notion of reality. The lines and shapes in my pieces do not merely depict reality; rather, they reveal it. This process of revelation is comparable to the frottage technique, where an artist uncovers hidden shapes by rubbing paper. In my practice, I search for meaningful lines and forms—sometimes by washing away sections of an already-painted canvas, and other times by deliberately leaving certain areas untouched.

The gaps, openings, and crevices created in this process—what I call **Between**—come together to form harmony and meaning within the painting. Such expressions serve as a reflection of our existence in the world.

From the very beginning of my process, I have used resin to merge the tactile qualities of plastic with painting. Resin obscures the underlying layers and creates a fragmented brushstroke structure when painted over, leading to unexpected results—something I find deeply intriguing. By dripping resin onto the canvas, I achieve a new visual effect similar to dripping acrylic paint. However, unlike paint, resin does not simply land on the surface; instead, it interacts with the material in a way that feels almost like an unfamiliar form of plastic.

I dedicate significant effort to ensuring that abstract expressionist forms harmonize with the plastic-like qualities of resin. This process involves dripping resin, spraying it again, and then wiping it off to create dynamic textures. Ultimately, the expressive mode of my work stems from my desire for modern technology to integrate seamlessly into our lives without threatening nature—just as modern society can never fully return to its past state.
