TITLE I PLAN SUMMARY 2023-2024

As a Title I school, we receive federal funding to provide children extra educational assistance. At the conclusion of the school year 75% of our students will be reading at or above grade level, as measured on literacy assessments, with a long-term goal to increase that number to 90%. Our current reality is that 62% of our students are proficient.

The funds we receive provide the following:

- Two sessions of preschool
- Highly qualified paraprofessionals that provide academic interventions and support under the direction of certified teachers
- Professional development for teachers with an emphasis on building an effective professional learning community and bolstering Tier I reading instruction
- Summer school
- Parent Nights
- A reading specialist
- Behavior Specialist
- An multilingual learner (ML) specialist

Greenwood is greatly benefiting from this funding. A copy of the entire Title I plan is available in the office.
