 - a) Organise the following descriptors into the correct module, after briefly analysing the introductions to the modules and some of the activities.
- Discuss the leadership at the end of the Cold War inferring from sources the conditions, events and human actions that led to its ending.
- Apply the research steps: make an hypothesis, research information, make connections and draw conclusions to answer the research question about post-cold war conflicts from different perspectives.
- Infer and classify the actions against Human Rights and values in post-Cold War international conflicts.

- Describe the main characteristics of the Franco dictatorship based on information from different perspectives.
- Infer and discuss what values, attitudes and initiatives are essential to improve coexistence, while remaining aware of the historical memory of the victims and human dignity.
- Identify and explain the main causes and events of the Cold War.

- Demonstrate your understanding of the insights that victims of violent past issues lived through based on their testimonies.
- Identify and infer from different types of sources (written, visual, oral,..) the characteristics of the Franco dictatorship.
- Identify and infer the perspectives, objectives and bias of some written sources (mainly protagonists' speeches) of the post-war period.
