
This feature must be compatible with the latest versions of WordPress (6.5.5) and PHP (8.3) and their previous versions.

1# Mobile Design Update for Social Share

Add options on different positions for mobile devices to ensure more responsiveness and a better user experience on small devices.


Sticky Bottom Bar:

- Add a sticky bottom bar, when tapped, opens a section with share buttons.
- Include a close (x) button; upon closing, display a share button in the bottom left.




Sticky Bottom Section:

• Implement a sticky bottom section with social share buttons.




Sticky Bottom Section with CTA:

• Create a sticky bottom section that includes both social share and call-to-action (CTA) buttons.



2# Create Custom Social Share Buttons

Built a Feature to create and add custom buttons—for example, contact us, link to our mobile app, etc.



You can use the following approach for that purpose:

Add options such as:

- 1. **Network ID**: Provide a unique identifier using lowercase Latin symbols (a-z) and numbers (0-9). Use underscores instead of spaces.
- 2. **Name**: Enter the text that will appear in the list of networks and on the button initially.
- 3. **Button URL**: Specify either a share command (you should fill at the proper places the variables representing sharable content like: *%%title%%*, *%%image%%*, *%%permalink%%*, *%%description%*, etc.) or a plain URL where visitors will be directed(i.e, contact page, affiliate page, purchase page).
- 4. **SVG Icon**: Insert the SVG code for the icon that will represent the button.

Optional Customization Options:

- Colors: Set default button colors for background, text, and icon.
- **Colors on Hover**: Define colors for background, text, and icon when hovering over the button. If not specified, default theme settings will be used.

Ensure proper validation and sanitization of user inputs to maintain security and functionality.

3# Button Styles

Create a separate section to set the style of buttons instead of adding separate templates/ designs. This section would primarily be used to set what to show on the social buttons.


Please note that this section does not replace the current social button designs. However, the purpose is to make a separate section for choosing the design/template and style (what to display) for buttons. In this way, the second last design would not be needed in the Social Buttons Designs section.



Create a New Section: Add a section titled "Social Buttons Styles" after the existing "Social Buttons Designs" section.

Display Options: Include the following options for choosing the button style:

- Regular Share Buttons with Icon & Name/Text: Display both the icon and the name/text of the social network.
- Share Button with Name/Text Only (No Icon): Show only the name/text of the social network without the icon.
- Share Button with Icon Only: Display only the icon of the social network.
- Share Button with Icon and Name/Text Appearing on Hover: Show the icon initially and display the name/text when hovered over.
- **Vertical Button**: Style the button to appear vertically oriented.



Ensure that selected styles are applied consistently across all instances of social buttons throughout your WordPress site.
