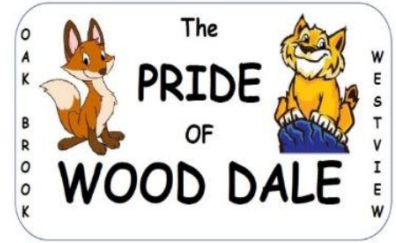


Oakbrook School & Westview School

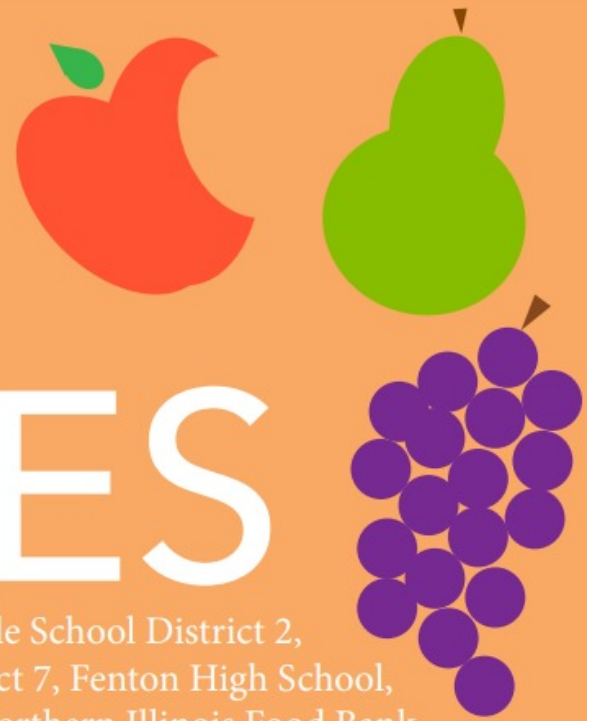

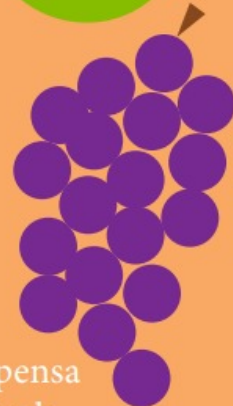
