#A Bill to Restructure the Educational Grant and Loan System of the United States

Be it ENACTED by the United States Senate and House of Representatives, in Congress Assembled.

\*\*SECTION I. LONG TITLE\*\*

A. This bill may be cited as "A Bill to Restructure the Educational Grant and Loan System of the United States".

\*\*SECTION II. SHORT TITLE\*\*

A. This bill may be cited as the Student Loan Elimination Act, or SLEA.

\*\*SECTION III. DEFINITIONS\*\*

A. "Student loan" shall refer to the borrowing of money from the United States federal government by an individual for the purpose of pursuing higher education.

- B. "Grant" shall refer to money given to a student by the federal government, either as a lump sum or credit, for the purposes of pursuing higher education.
- C. "Higher education" shall be defined as a degree or certificate obtained from a college or trade school.
- D. "Student debt" shall refer to debt accrued by an individual and owed to the federal government, taken for the purpose of pursuing higher education.

## \*\*SECTION IV. CANCELLATION OF STUDENT DEBT\*\*

A. No individual with current outstanding student debt shall be required to pay the total of said debt should their annual household income be below \$100,000, and no penalty shall be held for the individual's failure to do so

- B. The outstanding debt of each individual shall decrease by \$50,000 every year should their annual household income be between \$100,000 and \$250,000.
- >i. This deduction shall occur on the first of January every year following the passage of this act.
- \*\*SECTION V. RESTRUCTURING THE FEDERAL STUDENT AID SYSTEM\*\*
- A. All future student loans issued shall be repaid solely through a tax-based method, to be established by the Secretary of the Treasury.
- >i. These taxes shall not exceed 15% of the individual's personal income.

- B. \$10,000,000 shall be allocated to the Department of Education for the purpose of issuing grants to individuals in need.
- >i. The Department will issue these grants based on need, in accordance with guidelines set by the Secretary of Education.
- \*\*SECTION VI. IMPLEMENTATION\*\*
- A. This act shall take effect immediately.
- B. All provisions of this act are severable. Should a clause be struck from law, the rest shall remain.
