District Goal 1: Improve Attendance and Reduce Tardiness

To improve student attendance and reduce tardiness across all grade levels by implementing a proactive, tiered system of supports that promotes daily engagement and addresses the root causes of absenteeism. The number of

tardies per student will decrease by 10% which will reduce the district rate of chronic absenteeism.

District Goal 2: Implement Instructional Rounds to Strengthen Mathematics Instruction

To conduct Instructional Rounds focused on mathematics, with the aim of identifying and addressing instructional practices that impact student achievement. A minimum of three instructional rounds will be conducted and the team

will analyze and synthesize trends to create an action plan.

District Goal 3: Increase Science Academic Achievement

To increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding standards on the NJSLA Science assessment by 10 percentage points in the district. This will be achieved by promoting inquiry-based learning, aligning curriculum to the

NJ Student Learning Standards for Science (NJSLS), and fostering cross-grade coherence in science instruction.
