

Anki for Mac does not support embedded fonts. This means that fonts can't be retrieved from the Anki media folder and must be installed on the system like all other fonts. Separate font instructions must be given for Anki mobile and Anki Mac.

1. Download Matt's font collection.
2. Open Font Book on Mac
3. Click on the plus icon at the top of the Font Book window and select the four font files you've downloaded. This should import them and place them in a new 'user' tab on the left sidebar (if you have never installed user fonts before).
4. Copy and paste the fonts into the Anki Media Folder also:
/Users/{username}/Library/Application Support/Anki2/{userProfile}/collection.media
5. In Anki, open the browser and navigate to one of your RTK cards.
6. Click the "Cards..." button to open the card editor.
7. The next step is slightly different depending on whether OSX is in English or Japanese. Go to the English or Japanese section and copy and paste the chunks of code into the relevant fields.
