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Disaster CalFresh

No county is currently approved for Disaster CalFresh. People who lived or worked in a county approved for disaster calfresh and experienced an adverse effect (including lost food, wages) due to a natural disaster (ex: wildfires) may be eligible for Disaster CalFresh.

- **Who is eligible:** D-CalFresh is for people who are **not** already on CalFresh, but were affected by the disasters in the counties listed - **this includes if they lived or worked in this county and experienced harm.** People do not need an SSN to be eligible, but they need to [meet income guidelines](#).
- **How do people apply?:**
 - People can apply over the phone by calling their local county human services office, or in person at designated application sites.
- **Timeframe:** Applications for D-CalFresh can be submitted during a limited time period

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Hot and Prepared Foods

No county currently has a hot foods waiver, which, when approved, allows people who get CalFresh (and Disaster CalFresh) to use their benefits to buy hot and prepared foods at grocery stores and markets. Hot and prepared foods can include but are not limited to, items such as hot slices of pizza, hot soup, and rotisserie chicken. The hot foods waiver does not include restaurants.

- **What can be purchased:** Under normal circumstances, CalFresh recipients cannot purchase “hot foods and hot food products prepared for immediate consumption” (e.g., rotisserie chicken, hot food or, soup bars, etc.). This waiver allows CalFresh recipients to purchase hot and prepared food in recognition that households may have relocated or not have access to cooking equipment.
- **Who is impacted:** ALL CalFresh recipients living in the above list of counties can now purchase hot and prepared foods. They do not need to do anything to change their CalFresh case information.
- **What stores are participating:** All stores that already accept CalFresh EBT in the county above can now start approving purchases for hot and prepared foods; however, not all stores may be aware of this change. Please help us get the word out to retailers and report any issues or needs they face.

Timely Reporting Waiver for Food Loss For Current CalFresh Recipients

No County is currently approved for a Timely Reporting Waiver for Food Loss, which, when approved, allows CalFresh recipients more than 10 days to report food damage/loss and get their CalFresh replaced.

- **Background:**
 - Customers can report that their food was lost/damaged and get their CalFresh replaced *whenever they experience a loss*. They must report it to the county within 10 days of the loss/damage if their county isn't approved for a timely reporting waiver for Food Loss. Power outages, flooding, and evacuations are all events that can contribute to food loss/damage, in addition to fridge/freezer malfunction and other household emergencies.

- **How do people apply:**
 - There are multiple ways customers can report that the food they bought with CalFresh was lost or damaged. Customers can contact the county CalFresh office to report the loss/damage; the county will have them fill out a form ([CF 303](#)) and return it to the county. Automated Mass Replacement Waiver For Current CalFresh Recipients

No county is approved for an automated Mass Replacement Waiver, which, when approved, automatically gives CalFresh recipients full or partial CalFresh benefits back.

- **Background:**
 - Rather than SNAP households reporting their food loss through an individual affidavit, California can request an automated mass replacement for households who suffered food losses due to a situation like a long power outage or natural disaster.

- **How do people apply:**
 - There is no need to apply. Food benefits are automatically given to eligible households in impacted zip codes.
 - But remember that any customer, regardless of whether they live in these zip codes, can report that their food was lost/damaged and get their CalFresh replaced whenever they experience a loss. They must report it to the county within 10 days of the loss/damage (unless they have a Timely Reporting Waiver For Food Loss, see pg 3). Power outages, flooding, fires, and evacuations are all events that can contribute to food loss/damage, in addition to fridge/freezer malfunction and other household emergencies.

 - The waiver allowed for 40% of households' CalFresh allotment for the calendar month prior to January 6, 2025 to be automatically replaced without households having to submit paperwork to the county. The replacements were available on EBT cards on Friday, January 31, 2025.
