


Awesome Kidz 1

Unit 1 Lesson 13



Aim: Students will learn to recognize, trace, and identify the number "1" and its corresponding word "one". They will decorate number "one".

Time: 45-60 minutes

Materials:

- Crayons / Pencils
- Flashcards of number one and other random numbers (2-9) *attached
- Colored paper, glue, markers, stickers or pieces of yarn or other crafts
- Cutouts or worksheets with number "one" *attached

Tip: To ensure the lesson runs smoothly and students remain engaged, it's crucial to prepare and organize all materials ahead of time. Pre-fill Containers and organize glue. A well-prepared lesson reduces stress for both the teacher and the students, creating a more enjoyable and effective learning environment.

Engage:

Begin by holding up a large flashcard of the number "1" and the word "one". Explain to the students that today they will be learning about the number "1".

Choose 3 or 4 students from the class. Mix up the flashcards on a table and ask students to find and hold up the flashcard with number "one". Have several students take turns to do the same.

Explore & Practice:

Tracing the Number "1"

Demonstrate how to trace the number "1" on the board or a sheet of paper or on the whiteboard. Have some students take turns to come to the front and trace the number.

With the Book

Ask the students to trace the number "1" on their own sheets, following the dashed lines. Walk around and assist students who may need help.

Circle the Number "1"

Direct students to the section of the worksheet where they need to circle the number "1" among other numbers.

Explain that they need to look carefully and circle every instance of the number "1". Demonstrate how to circle the number and have students do it on their books.

Number "1" Craft



Give each student a cut-out of the number "1" to decorate with stickers, markers, yarn, and other craft supplies.

Closing:

Review

Ask the students to hold up their decorated "1" and say the number out loud. Review the word "one" and ask students to read it out loud together.

Praise the students for their hard work and creativity. Briefly preview that in the next lessons, they will learn about more numbers.



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
