## **FUTURE**

will - make spontaneous decision (<u>make decision at the moment</u> of speaking)

promise (I will be in time)
offer (I'll turn on AC)
request (Will you open the door for me?)
prediction (based on your opinion: I think you will like it)

be going to + V1 - plans & intentions (I am going to buy a new car).

make decisions before the moment of speaking

predictions (based on facts, evidence, info)

**Present Continuous** - fixed plans/100% sure plans (appointment; tickets; arranged time and date..)

I'm seeing my friends on Friday evening. I'm having lunch with my co-worker today.

**Present Simple** - scheduled events (<u>timetable</u>: transport, school, business hours, movie, concert, gym..)

The next bus comes in 20 min.

This bank closes at 5 pm.

What time does the store open?

May / might + V1 - uncertain plans (I might / may see my friend after work.)

**Hope + Present Simple -** I hope you feel better soon. / I hope we can meet again someday.
