- Your news writing articles should be between 500-800 words in length
- The article must be your original work

- Video

- Inspiration, ideas, "how to attempt" can be found here
- Anyone may be in the video (must have permission from individual), including yourself, and there is no person limit

- Between 2:00 to 6:00 minutes
- Ensure the highest resolution as possible (if the quality is too low, it may be disqualified)
- All footage must be horizontally recorded (this is to avoid having blank rectangles on either side)
- May use any app or software to assemble video
- No watermarks on media or any copyrighted material (may include watermarks from editing software)

- Podcast

- Anyone may be in the podcast, including yourself, and there is no person limit
- Between 2:00 minutes to 8:00 minutes
- Be mindful of background noise and sound quality (if the quality is too poor and there is too much background noise, it may be disqualified)
- If you need some guidance, take a look at AUSD's Keepin' It Arcadia's Podcast

- Graphic Design

- If making multiple graphic designs, they must all be part of one single project/product
- Make sure all words and messages are legible
- No watermarks in graphic design(s)
- May use any app, software, or design medium to create design
- Ensure the highest resolution possible (if the quality is too low, it may be disqualified)
