

20 Minute Lesson Plan

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House: North

Essential Question: What is the most significant when perceiving beauty in the United States?

Objectives: I am going to be teaching the class about how the idea of beauty has changed from the 1950's to now. They will learn what kind of a woman was viewed as beautiful back then, and why it has changed.

Introduction	- Name - Topic - E.Q - Quick explanation of what I'll be talking about	2 min	Three Important Sources "Beauty and Body image in the media" the article explains how the media dictates our views on beautiful women "History of beauty through the ages" shows exactly how the idea of beauty has changed with the times "What is beautiful" gives a basic explanation of how different cultures define beautiful women
Verification (Steps to check for student understanding)	- I will first ask the students if they think the idea of beauty has changed at all since the 1920's - End: I'll check for understanding by asking why they think the idea of beauty has changed so much	2-3 min	

Body (Give and/or demonstrate necessary information)	<i>Literal:</i> I will talk about beauty as seen in the 20's, 50's, and 90's. <i>Interpretive:</i> What the basics of beauty were in each decade <i>Applied:</i> This shows how the idea of beauty has changed in the past 90 years.	- Literal: 5 min - Interp: 2 min - Applied: 2 min	Visuals I will have a powerpoint with pictures from each decade
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Activity: On my powerpoint, i will have 2 pictures, side by side, and will have the students, in their group, figure out which decade the picture was from, as well as stating who they think was more popular because of their image.		5 min	Materials (for activity) Powerpoint slides
