

Suspension and Expulsion Policy

Blooming Blossoms will provide a purposeful and engaging environment to support cultural diversity and the different stages of child development. We will encourage a confident sense of self, self-regulation, and support conflict resolution. If a child's behavior become aggressive or unsafe for other children, the following steps to correct the behavior will be taken.

1. A behavior chart/reward system will be implemented to encourage and support positive behavior and child's self-worth.
2. We will engage the family to collaborate child's behavior. We will work together to find a resolution that works at home or in other settings.
3. We will help support the family to identity outside agencies to assist in the correction of behavioral issues.
4. If all attempts to correct aggressive or unsafe behavior cannot be correct we will ask the child to not return.

The suspension and expulsion policy will only be used as a last resort to protect other children and Caregivers.
