## WILLIAM E. NORRIS PRESCHOOL PROGRAM INFORMATION 2025-2026

The Town of Southampton offers a public inclusion preschool program to meet the mandate for educating preschool children with disabilities. The program is open to families who have three and four year old children (must be 3 by September 1st). Also, five year olds whose birthdays come after September 1st.

The Norris preschool program can accommodate children with and without disabilities from Southampton. By integrating children in this way, each population benefits and enriches the other. Carefully designed activities provide excellent social experiences, increased self-confidence, a base for understanding people with disabilities, a foundation of preschool skills and joyful play that is central to the early childhood stage of development.

## Schedule & Tuition:

- Sessions: 4 half-day sessions per week (Monday–Thursday).
- Each session is 2.5 hours.
- Tuition: \$240/month.
- A sliding scale is available for financial assistance. Contact the school for details.

If your child turns 3 after March 6th, but before September 1, please complete the forms below and return them to the school office no later than March 7th for consideration.

Screening dates are **March 5th and 6th** and are by appointment only. Screenings will be held for children who will be at least three years old by March 7th. A preschool screening is a brief assessment of a child's development and skills before they start school.

Beginning on January 27th, screening appointments may be scheduled by calling 413-333-5500. Appointments are approximately 30 minutes.
