The abstract must be written in both Indonesian and English.

INTRODUCTION (Cambria 12 pt, 1.5 spacing)

The introduction in *IQOMAH: Journal of Community Engagement* articles should include the practical and academic background of the community issues or needs that form the basis of the engagement activity. This section should also describe the social significance of the chosen issue, outline the focus of the engagement activity, and specify the contribution offered to enhance community capacity, quality of life, or empowerment based on Islamic values.

The writing should be narrative and argumentative, supported by relevant literature or prior studies as a theoretical and contextual foundation. Avoid overly general or descriptive explanations; instead, highlight the relevance of the activity to real community needs and its potential for sustainable impact. If possible, also mention any gaps in prior engagement efforts or innovative approaches that distinguish this activity from similar programs. The ideal length for this section is 600–700 words, emphasizing the benefits of the activity, the integration of Islamic values in community service, and the active involvement of the community as the main subject of the activity.

Example of body note:

Community empowerment through an Islamic values-based approach not only aims to address social issues but also strengthens the spiritual and moral identity of the target community. In this context, community engagement must be grounded in an ethical and transformative framework as emphasized in the principle of *rahmatan lil 'alamin* (Rahman 2023, 78).

At least 80% of the references must come from the last 5 years, following the *Chicago Manual of Style 17th Edition* (full note) with an in-text citation system. Zotero/Mendeley should be used as reference managers.
