The Division offers families the choice of a range of alternative programs. Enrolment of new students in any Division alternative program is not guaranteed.

- a. Alternative programs follow the same enrolment priorities as regular programs. New students to a school are accepted in an alternative program in the following order:
  - i. <u>Resident</u> students who live in the <u>attendance area</u>, and who are currently in the alternative program in a Division school.
  - ii. Resident students who live in the attendance area.
  - iii. Resident students who live in the program enrolment boundary (where applicable).
  - iv. <u>Siblings</u> of students currently in the alternative program at the school and who will be returning the following year.
  - v. <u>Resident</u> students currently enrolled in another division in the same alternative program.
  - vi. Other resident students. (not applicable to High School)
  - vii. Non-resident students currently enrolled in the alternative program in the Division.
  - viii. Non-resident students currently in the alternative program in another division.
  - ix. Other non-resident students.
- b. A student enrolled in a Division alternative program may continue to be enrolled in the program at the same school. If the next grade is unavailable at the student's current school, and the alternative program is offered at the subsequent grade in the Division, students who are currently enrolled in the alternative program in the Division will continue to have access to that program at a new school.
