 - Looks reasonable to choose mascot by end of year, if work is diligent
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"Pre Competition" Sub Committee:

- Football team is ordering new jerseys on June 10 so mascot needs to be chosen by then
- Waiting on Values committee to decide criteria for submissions
- Reaching out to other schools and the community are important tasks
 - Alumni
 - It is hard to contact all alumni
 - Alumni Facebook group has a lot of members
 - Ask if alumni want a say in our new mascot
 - Middle School
 - Should they be allowed to submit options?
 - It is their future school
 - Community Outreach
 - Hanover Listserv
 - How would the community like to be involved?
 - Other Schools with Mascot Changes
 - Rutland
 - Lebanon
 - Survey to school
 - Ask "How should the mascot be chosen?"
 - Budgeting surveys is important to ensure high response rates
- New mascot will need to be sent to digitizing company
- Dartmouth Art Department
 - Ask for recommendations on how to draw specific design
- Advertising Competition
 - Newspaper article or ad - would need to know before competition to write and article
- Funding for Mascot Digitalization
 - What committee is responsible for finding this money?
 - Motion to Council is an option but Council does not have this money
 - Is the administration supplying it?

- Lebanon Mascot Change Process
 - 200-300 submissions
 - Committee narrowed it down to top 3
 - School voted out of top 3
- Explanation Required for Submissions
 - Focus Questions - Value's Committee's decision
 - Making sure submissions are serious
- Advisory Challenge
 - Under Council prevu
 - Prize such as a Pizza Party
 - Lunch line order

"Values" Sub Committee:

- Form to be sent out to school community in Friday Focus
 - This data will be taken under advisement and then sent to the Pre Competition committee
 - Purpose of committee and documents outlining committee should be attached to form
 - "Hearts, Minds, and Voices" should be a main point when choosing values but there are values that do not fit into these three categories
 - Survey should be concise and simple - high response rate
 - At least 7 and 8th grade RMS student opinion will be considered because they were asked if they thought the mascot should be changed
 - RMS 6th grade should be included if they were asked before
 - If RMS 6th grade then MCS 6th grade
 - Values to choose from should be alphabetical so that some are not favored
 - Values discussed during meeting should be listed as examples and responders should choose their own values
 - Survey will currently be sent to just HHS community
 - Final chosen questions were roughly:
 - What categories do you fall under? (staff, student, parent etc.)
 - What three values, that represent HHS, should be considered?

- What should the new mascot take the form of? (category: animal, weather etc.)
