Art

<u>Kindergarten</u>- Kindergarten students continue to develop their art vocabulary and skills. In October, students describe lines, shapes, and color in artworks. They represent ideas and forms from their environment visually from observation, memory, and imagination.



<u>1st Grade</u>- Students use color, line, shape, texture, and form to represent ideas visually from observation, memory, and imagination. Also, students develop and apply criteria in the creation and evaluation of artwork using art vocabulary.

2nd Grade- Students analyze ways artists manipulate space and explore techniques to create the illusion of space in the depiction of objects and the environment. Students develop and apply criteria in the evaluation of artwork.

<u>3rd Grade</u>- Students carefully analyze ways that artists use the art elements, design principles, and techniques to achieve a desired result. The learning towards the end of October provides students the opportunity to apply observed techniques to their own work throughout the school year.

<u>4th Grade</u>- Students make connections between art and the world by examining relationships among what is observed and using processes from other disciplines to create artwork. Students will establish and use criteria for judging artwork.

<u>5th Grade</u>- Students take a closer look at how artists express ideas about human experience. The learning in October provides students the opportunity to apply observed techniques to their own work. Also, students will apply criteria to evaluate artwork.

4th grade will be learning about and performing I-V chords on our Orff (xylophone) instruments.


5th grade scholars have begun to prepare to attend a Blues concert in person at the Strathmore Music Center on October 28.
