Bylaws Amendments:

Minutes (please refer to linked slides for more information)

- Presented bill to allocate \$7,000 from reserves to undergraduates without access to Institute laundry (\$10 Tech Cash per student living in graduate dorms and off-campus; per-capita for Institute living groups without laundry)
 - Arguments between giving \$10 Tech cash and lump sum for FSILGs
 - Concern over lump sum option being distributed in a timely manner
 - Proposal to increase budget to \$10,000
 - Would be pulled from reserves, which have too much funds currently
 - PASSED: allocate \$10,000 from reserves to undergraduates without access to Institute laundry (give lump sum to FSILGs on per capita basis; give \$10 Tech Cash to remaining students)

- Yes: all but Baker, 1 IFC
- No:
- Abstain: Baker, 1 IFC
- Presentation on SpringFest from SEB
 - Request for \$40,000 from reserves for enhancing the concert (better production and bigger artist), additional carnival ride, more food, more merch, decrease cost of tickets, subsidize more booths
 - Artist already chosen (contract not yet signed—need funds before this can happen)
 - This funding is beyond what is normally allocated to SpringFest
 - Suggestion to allocate \$25k from PB funds and \$15k form reserves
 - Counterargument for 5k from PB
 - Some pushes for full amount from reserves
 - Spending the PB funds instead of reserves makes no difference
 - Hope for more collaboration between UA and SEB in the future
 - PASSED: give \$40k to SEB for SpringFest from reserves
 - Yes: all but EC
 - No:
 - Abstain: EC
- PB funding reallocation proposal from *The Tech* from editor-in-chief Karie Shen
 - Current funds primarily from ads (completely independent from UA and Institute funding)
 - Potential UA funding (non-journalistic and without printing/distribution) opportunities amounting to \$17,040
 - Suggested to provide \$7k and bring up issue regarding paying student appointments
 - Production staff are compensated, writers are not, business will ideally be in the future, technology turned down funding
 - Piloting increasing issue frequency from once every other week to weekly, which would require increased funding
 - Would cost \$20k more
 - Concern over if other student groups would want PB funding
 - Suggestion to pull from discretionary funds from FinBoard
 - Vote DELAYED to next Council meeting
- Additional PB funding reallocation proposals: IFair from David Kwabi-Addo (ISA), EC Exhibition
 - UA History budget expended; arguments regarding the fairness of funding EC over other dorms
 - UA History ultimately requesting \$4,250
 - IFair requesting \$5,000
- Meeting over time; bylaws and amendments in offline discussions
 - Criticism of Council to address agenda items in a more timely manner
- Final PB funding allocation vote proposed (TABLED): \$10k for The Tech, \$4.25k for UA
 History, \$5k for IFair
 - Requests for additional information from The Tech about what the funds will be used for
 - Could ask for report on what the spend the money on
