GATEWAY SPEAKING EXAM

Date: 29-30 May 2025 (Thursday & Friday)

Starting time: 09:15 (An appointment time will be set for each student. Each student will have 10 minutes.)

Information on the Speaking Exam:

- (1) An appointment time will be set for each student and the list will be shared with students at least one day before the exam. Please check the announcements made by the proctor on 28 May.
- (2) Please do not be late for your appointment. Arrive at the exam venue at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time. The students who do not take the exam on the exam date will be deemed to have given up his/her right to take the speaking exam.
- (3) You will be asked to show your ID card (passport for foreign students) and/or student ID card before the exam starts. Please take these documents with you.
- (4) The audio recording will begin as soon as you enter the exam room, and your performance will be recorded. You will be asked to introduce yourself briefly; however, this part will not be graded.
- (5) The speaking exam consists of two parts. At the beginning of the first part, the instructors will give you a cue card. You will be asked to read the topic on it out loud. You will have 1 minute to think and take notes. When the time is up, you are required to answer each of the questions. In the second part, you will be asked some follow-up questions about the given topic. Click HERE to see the sample speaking exam.
- **(6)** The speaking exam sessions are conducted and evaluated **by two instructors**. Click **HERE** to see the evaluation criteria.
