Instructions

- Invite students to write 2-3 things about themselves on a piece of paper, then crumple it.
- Then have each student stay in their “spot,” remaining a socially acceptable distance apart and without touching their face, have a “snowball fight” with the crumpled papers for about 1 minute.
- Give students another round of hand sanitizer
- The teacher can then go around the room, picking random “snowballs” to read out loud. No comments necessary, but ask students to make a mental note of any similarities between the items on the paper and themselves.

Time: 10-12 minutes

Instructions

Students will line up shoulder to shoulder in alphabetical order by first name. A list of 15 “have you ever..” questions will be read aloud to the students. If they answer “yes” to the question, the student will take one step forward and if they answer no, they will remain standing in the same spot until the next question is asked.
