MOTION: Insert the following underlined Safety statement paragraph between the two existing paragraphs in the Sample format for Nar-Anon meetings on **page 3-2 and 3-3** in the English version of the **Guide to Local Service**. Leader/Chair - Anything you hear tonight is strictly our own opinion. The principles of Nar-Anon are found in our Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions. If a member says something here that you cannot accept, remember he or she is speaking from their own experience, they are not speaking for Nar-Anon. When you leave our meeting, take home those thoughts that will be most helpful to you, forget those you feel will not be helpful, and keep coming back. We ask that you speak only as a member of Nar-Anon unless you were invited as a speaker from NA.

Leader/Chair - In dealing with the addiction of a family member or friend, we may have experienced inappropriate behavior. We have learned through our meetings we no longer have to accept inappropriate behavior, threats, or intimidation; this is especially true in our rooms. A Nar-Anon meeting should always be a safe place for its members.

Leader/Chair - In Nar-Anon meetings, we do not engage in crosstalk. Personal progress for the greatest number depends on unity; therefore, we take turns sharing our own experience, strength, and hope. We do not interrupt each other or engage in dialogue; we do not put the spotlight on just one member; and we do not give advice, offer solutions, or try to rescue one another. By patiently listening, we show respect for each other and concern for the common welfare of the group. Loving interchange can occur outside the meeting time through one-on-one or group conversations, shared meals, e-mail, telephone, and sponsorship.



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MOTION APPLIES TO: (Which areas of Nar-Anon does this motion apply to? INTENT: Safety for all members is important. Nar-Anon Family Group meetings should be a safe place to share our experience, strength, and hope. Adding this excerpt from the Inappropriate Behavior booklet, which is conference approved literature, will reinforce the importance of personal safety in and outside our meetings. This will enhance members' state of mind regarding the subject of safety.

RATIONALE: Addiction is a dangerous disease. Our sense of safety has been impaired by the time we find Nar-Anon. Our meetings become a safe island of hope in a life made chaotic by addiction. We benefit from the constant reminder of the importance of safety in our lives, both in and outside our meetings.
