



Uniform Policy

1. Policy Statement

The Board of Management of Ballygiblin National School recognises the importance of a school uniform in promoting a positive sense of identity, belonging and pride in the school community.

Ballygiblin National School uses a PE / activewear-style uniform as its daily school uniform. This reflects the practical, active and inclusive nature of school life and supports pupils to participate comfortably in learning, play and physical activity throughout the school day.

The school seeks to ensure that the uniform is practical, comfortable, affordable and suitable for everyday wear.

2. Purpose of the Policy

The purpose of this policy is to:

- provide clarity regarding the school uniform
- promote a neat, practical and consistent standard of dress
- support pupil comfort, inclusion and participation in school life
- encourage a sense of pride and belonging in Ballygiblin National School
- provide a fair and workable framework for parents/guardians and staff

3. School Uniform

The daily school uniform in Ballygiblin National School is the school PE / activewear uniform.

The uniform consists of the items approved by the school and supplied through the school's designated uniform supplier, **ID Sports**.

Details of the approved items will be communicated to parents/guardians through the school's official channels.

4. General Expectations

Pupils are expected to wear the school uniform each day unless otherwise advised by the school.

The uniform should be:

- clean and presentable
- comfortable and suitable for active participation in school life
- practical for indoor and outdoor activity
- appropriate for the age and needs of the child

Footwear should be safe, practical and suitable for normal school activity and play.

Parents/guardians are asked to ensure that all uniform items are clearly labelled.

5. Flexibility and Practicality

The school recognises that a practical and reasonable approach is important. The implementation of this policy will be guided by common sense, inclusion and the best interests of pupils.

Where necessary, the school may allow reasonable flexibility in particular circumstances, including where this is appropriate on practical, financial, medical, sensory or other relevant grounds.

6. Communication with Parents/Guardians

Details of the current approved uniform items, supplier arrangements and ordering information through **ID Sports** will be communicated separately to parents/guardians by the school.

Any future updates to approved uniform arrangements will also be communicated through the school's usual channels.

7. Review

This policy will be reviewed by the Board of Management as required and in line with school need.

8. Ratification

This policy was reviewed and adopted by the Board of Management of Ballygiblin National School on June 18th 2026
