

Overview

ProbeNative is a native library inspection tool for Android. It operates entirely on-device and does not collect, store, transmit, or share any personal or sensitive user data.

Data Collection

ProbeNative does ****not**** collect any data. Specifically:

- No personal information (name, email, phone number, etc.)
- No device identifiers or advertising IDs
- No location data
- No usage analytics or crash reports
- No cookies or tracking technologies
- No data is sent to any server, third party, or remote service

Permissions

ProbeNative requests the following permissions solely for its core functionality:

| Permission | Purpose |

| `QUERY_ALL_PACKAGES` | Required to list installed applications for analysis. No app data is collected or transmitted. |

| `READ_EXTERNAL_STORAGE` | Required to read APK files on the device for native library and ELF header inspection. No files are copied, uploaded, or shared. |

How the App Works

ProbeNative reads publicly accessible APK files of installed applications to inspect their native libraries and ELF binary metadata. All analysis is performed locally on your device. No information about your installed apps or their libraries ever leaves your device.

Third-Party Services

ProbeNative does not integrate any third-party services, SDKs, analytics platforms, ad networks, or cloud services.

Children's Privacy

ProbeNative does not collect any data from any user, including children under the age of 13. The app is a developer tool and does not target children.

Data Security

Since no data is collected or transmitted, there is no data to secure. All analysis results exist only in the app's local memory during use and are discarded when the app is closed.
