

How to Apply to Bay College

Applying to Bay is a part of enrolling in a CTE Early Middle College Program. Students in each CTE EMC pathway start taking actual Bay College courses at different times. Some don't enroll in an actual Bay course until their 5th year. Some start earlier by taking Bay courses online. Applying to Bay College does not cost any money and does not commit you to enrolling in any classes. You can always change your mind and withdraw from the EMC program, although we discourage withdrawal during your 5th year.
