



PLANNING • WHAT TO EXPECT

“Arrival at PDX” July 4

- Be sure you know your specific time to be at PDX (based on your flight's departure time)!
 - When you arrive at PDX, be sure you have everything before your parent/guardian leave.
 - Wear your OAM tour t-shirt.
 - Make sure your luggage and instrument (if applicable) have MCI luggage tags.
 - Report to the ticketing level at the counter for your airline. You will see OAM staff there wearing our tour t-shirts and/or staff jackets.
 - Stay patient and follow all instructions.
 - Find your chaperone and chaperone group (some flight chaperone groups may be slightly different for flight process only). This will be discussed at camp.
 - Stay with your chaperone and chaperone group at all times.
 - Your group will check-in together and go through security together.
 - Once through security and at the gate (if time allows), your chaperone can coordinate bathroom trips and venues to eat as they see fit. You must have their permission and remain in groups of 3 or more. Your group needs to check back in with the chaperone upon returning to the gate. Again, only your chaperone will coordinate these situations. Be patient and communicate.
- If you have assigned OAM equipment, be sure to collect it from Erik Dabel (OAM equipment manager) before you check-in. We will go over this at camp.
