Be prepared and expect to be sent TDY/TAD for some of your clinical rotations throughout the program. During the first 12 months of both program options (DNP), the focus of the learning is on core advanced practice nursing sciences, evidence-based practice, and program-specific courses. Although the majority of your time will be spent in the classroom setting, all students will experience a clinical immersion at the end of the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters that may involve a 2-3 week TAD/TDY travel.

The clinical rotations begin to ramp up in the 2nd year-summer of the program, where the focus shifts to an emphasis on clinical application of knowledge
