

## **ADULT-GERONTOLOGY CLINICAL NURSE SPECIALIST**

Be prepared and expect to be sent TDY/TAD for some of your clinical rotations throughout the program. During the first 12 months of both program options ( DNP), the focus of the learning is on core advanced practice nursing sciences, evidence-based practice, and program- specific courses. Although the majority of your time will be spent in the classroom setting, all students will experience a clinical immersion at the end of the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters that may involve a 2-3 week TAD/TDY travel.

The clinical rotations begin to ramp up in the 2nd year-summer of the program, where the focus shifts to an emphasis on clinical application of knowledge
