This is an updating list, if you see any examples you're aware of that are missing, please let me know and I'll update the list appropriately. This list was made primarily by a Death Battle fan in hopes to see the show improve. It's fair to speak for most fans at large when saying that none of this can be assumed to be malicious behavior from the Death Battle staff who are intentionally trying to avoid crediting fan works. Especially with corporate bureaucracy in mind, it's most likely a lot more difficult than you might think to make certain changes retroactively and add credit. That's not mentioning the talented animators and production crew who bring the fights to life in the first place, and all the effort they go through. Ultimately though, Death Battle has consistently struggled to credit fan works appropriately across its entire history, and it continues to be a major problem all the way up to the most recent episodes. We as a community believe that something has to change, and that this is a problem that can be fixed. The hope is that the production of this document encourages the team to fix things now and do better in the future by both the fans and the creators in question whose works are used.

Of note is that Deadpool's render in both his preview thumbnail against Deathstroke and the thumbnail of vs Pinkie Pie is fanart, but has been spread around and reused so much over the years that the original artist may just be lost.

Uncredited sprites/models

Also note that none of the re-uploads in the recent fight only videos on the Death Battle channel feature any credit to the original sprite artists, so every one of those videos needs to be edited to feature credit all the same.

This document will be providing links to the best of its ability to some kind of site proving that the original sprite artists created the sprite in question, such as a mugenarchive download page or a wiki page/forum post describing the original author and giving a download link. Mugenarchive can be unreliable even at the best of times and is itself a controversial site when it comes to crediting (not helped by its wars against other MUGEN warehouses), so it can be difficult to tell when a person listed is just making an edit or doing gameplay adjustments as opposed to actually being involved in producing the sprite art. I've tried my best to place the original artists and provide adequate links, but reach out if you spot anything wrong with this list.

Death Battle

It's worth noting that in Haggar vs Zangief, the first use of a fan-made sprite in the show, the end credits specifically verbally shouted out Acey, the co-creator of the sprite, while also linking to their Youtube channel. The same occurred with Mario vs Sonic 1, Eggman vs Wily, Thor vs Raiden. Early Death Battle also credited even the people who ripped sprites from official sources and also listed the sources used for footage in the credits. Occasionally, later episodes like Black Widow vs Widowmaker will make a distinction between official models and community-made models, alongside crediting where all the assets come from. These examples are a more ideal way of handling such cases, but as can be seen, it's inconsistent.

An important point isn't just the credit existing, it's how the credit is given. In a lot of cases, DB's form of credit takes the form of the original artist's name coming up for a very small window of time in the credits in minor text at the very end of the video. For the Krillin vs Tien vs Yamcha DBX for example, you can find a MUGEN forum thread with the original sprite artist where it was

directly pointed out how leaving the credits out of the description and flashing them on screen so quickly is still harmful (alongside mistakenly giving credit to someone not involved in making the sprites). Other examples of this have come up plenty, such as Mr Fantastic's DBX appearance listing Darkwolf'13 and Walruslui as "Sprite Artists" despite the fact that they only translated the MUGEN's character gameplay, while ZVitor is the original sprite creator. In general, it's rather inconsistent, the Thunder Megazord's sprite ripper Grim is credited but plenty of other cases where the person who ripped the sprite isn't.

It's definitely better than nothing, but a vague "Original Sprites" credit which appears very briefly in the end credits is never going to be ideal, and DB is vague in many cases on which sprite artist made what sprites, and how said content was used for the video. Especially given Death Battle frequently gets major sponsorships and revenue while using community-made work without explicit permission, it's understandable why certain artists may argue that the form the credit takes isn't given enough emphasis. As mentioned before, early DB provides a good example of this. The difficulty of providing credit in an appropriate manner has definitely increased over time as the YouTube algorithm has changed and Death Battle itself has massively increased in scope, so there's definitely a lot to consider, but a lot of room for improvement.

The short and its creator aren't referenced anywhere in the video directly
- Hercules vs Sun Wukong:

The entire basis of Wukong's research was aided by and frequently refers to the Journey To The West Research Blog by anthropologist Jim R. McClanahan. This blog is listed in the suggested media for the matchup, but is not mentioned or referred to anywhere in the episode as a source. In spite of the fact that said blog did an analysis of the Death Battle after it came out, and explicitly requested some form of credit, the video has still not been updated.

On the note of fan-art, early episodes frequently used fan-art as footage filler at various points, even ending up as the reason Ragna vs Sol was copyright struck due to lack of credit. At least from a look through each episode, these seem to largely go credited (though there might be something I'm missing, in which case please let me know and I'll add it), but the credit is completely separate from the fan-art itself, such as tokyozombie's episode fan-art being featured at the very beginning of episodes with no indication of who made it, and their name only being featured in the credits at the very end of said episodes with no indication of what their art was, which needless to say is pretty unideal for crediting fan work. This can be seen in other episodes as well, such as BladeofGoth's Sol vs Ragna fan-art being featured in the intro of the episode while credit is only featured briefly at the end, and has caused issues in the past, so it's something to keep in mind for all forms of fan works.
