
What is trackcross?

Trackcross is a racing event where cars will go onto an official road circuit/track, one driver at a time! It's basically like doing time trials in racing games, trying to set your best time, in real life!

I want to drive! What do I need to do?

- Register!!! (but read the entire thing first)
- Be 18+ years of age with a valid driver's license
- Pass tech inspection
 - Please print out inspection sheets before arriving so you are prepared for the techs
 to quickly inspect your car. There will be a lot of people and we have to get cars
 through inspection as quickly as we can. Inspection papers at Summit cost \$20!
 - Your car must be safe to drive! This means no leaks, your battery is secure, no loose screws, and definitely no broken subframe!
 - LOANER HELMETS WILL BE PROVIDED!!! NASA Mid Atlantic has generously let us borrow SNELL rated helmets for our event!
 - Convertibles need roll-over protection! Usually, most modern convertibles have built-in roll-over protection, but make sure your specific model does, as you won't get a refund! Your head (with helmet on) should also easily be below the top of the windshield, also known as the broom test! All Mazda Miatas, Honda S2000s, and Dodge Viper convertibles need to have 4-point full width roll bars installed.

Class your car

- Car numbers!! You must choose a unique car number when you register for the
 event. This number must be displayed and visible on both sides of your cars (front
 doors) and at least 12 inches tall. Vinyl is recommended, but 3M automotive tape
 does the job great too! Make sure it contrasts from the color of your car.
- Not everyone can afford a GT3RS, so car classes even out the playing field!
 - Novice class is for first timers and beginners! Regardless of what car you drive, if you have less than 5 performance driving events, you must be in this class!
 - <u>Street class</u> is for street legal production cars that are stock or have limited/basic bolt-on modifications.
 - <u>Competition class</u> is for street legal or non street legal competition or racing prepared cars with more extensive modifications.
 - Expo class is the "catch-all" class! If you're here to be a chill guy and just have fun (and aren't a beginner), this is the class for you!

Don't be late!!

 This event has a mandatory driver's meeting, where there will be important information. Show up early to meet up with people, do some last minute prep, or grab a quick bite!

Any other things I should know?

KNOW YOUR LIMITS

- How much experience you have driving on backroads or how much horsepower your car makes does not matter here. DO NOT push yourself or your car too hard while you're driving, especially if this is your first time.
- YOU are financially responsible for any accident or crash that causes damage to your car, your body, the facility, or any equipment. An additional fee of \$100 will be billed for each call to use a tow truck.

What's the event schedule like?

- o 6:30AM gates open
- o 7:00AM registration & tech open
- o 8:00AM driver's meeting & novice classroom
- o 8:45AM group A drive on course 1
- 10:30AM group B of cars drive on course 1
- o 12:00PM lunch & course reset
- 1:00PM group A drive on course 2
- o 2:30PM group B of cars drive on course 2

How much does it cost?

- As college students, we understand that money is important and racing is expensive. That's why we've made entry fees remarkably cheap compared to other track events!
- You are not required to work or volunteer for any sessions, which leaves more time for you to get ride-alongs or just hang around and enjoy the view!
- We have decided to remove the late registration fee! However, not many spots remain so register while you still can!

■ Normal registration: \$120
