Neighbors with appointments are welcome to shop every other week. We are open for appointments ONLY on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Friday. (appointments are currently full).

If any applicant needs emergency food assistance at another time, they may contact The Met Church office and will be given additional food based on the current food pantry inventory.
