



## eXp Email Alias Forwarding Guide

An email alias is simply a forwarding email address. The mail server simply forwards email messages addressed to an email alias on to another, the specified email address.

So in an agent's case, when an email is sent to [firstname.lastname@exprealty.com](mailto:firstname.lastname@exprealty.com), it automatically forwards to their personal email address on file. Since this is an alias, there is no login information needed as there is nothing to log into, other than your personal email address.

If the agent would like to send emails from their eXp email address, they will need to use either a Gmail or Yahoo personal email address. Here are instructions on how to configure each email service to send as the eXp email alias:

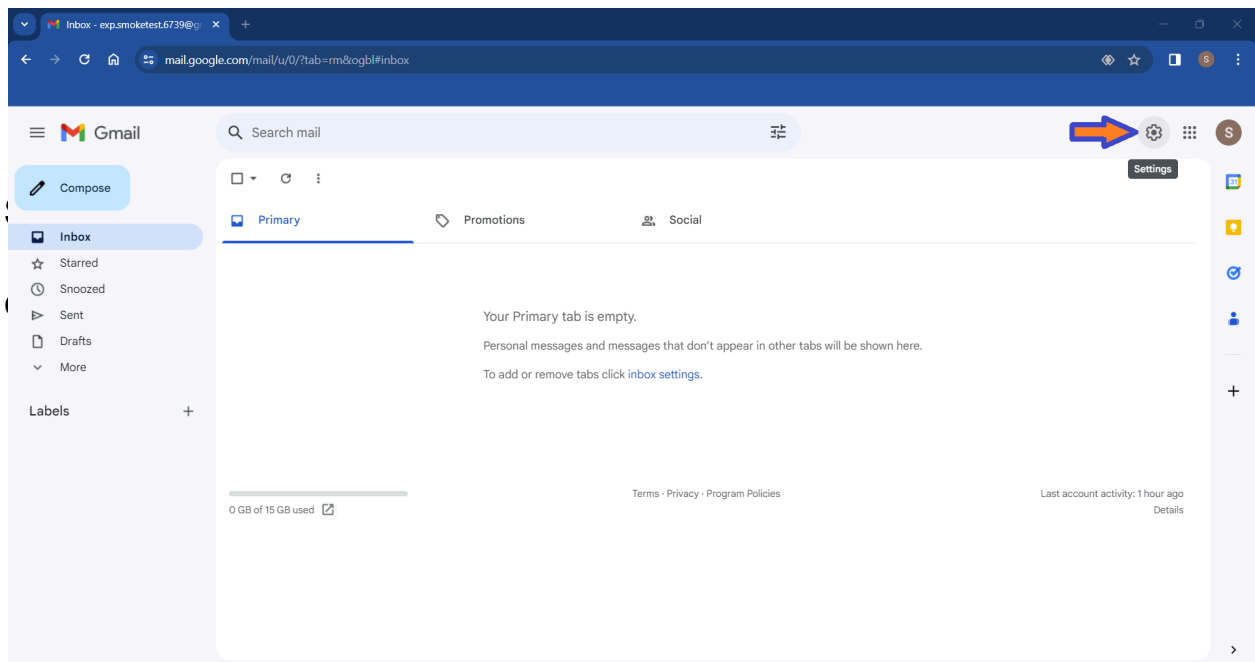
## Gmail & Yahoo Instructions

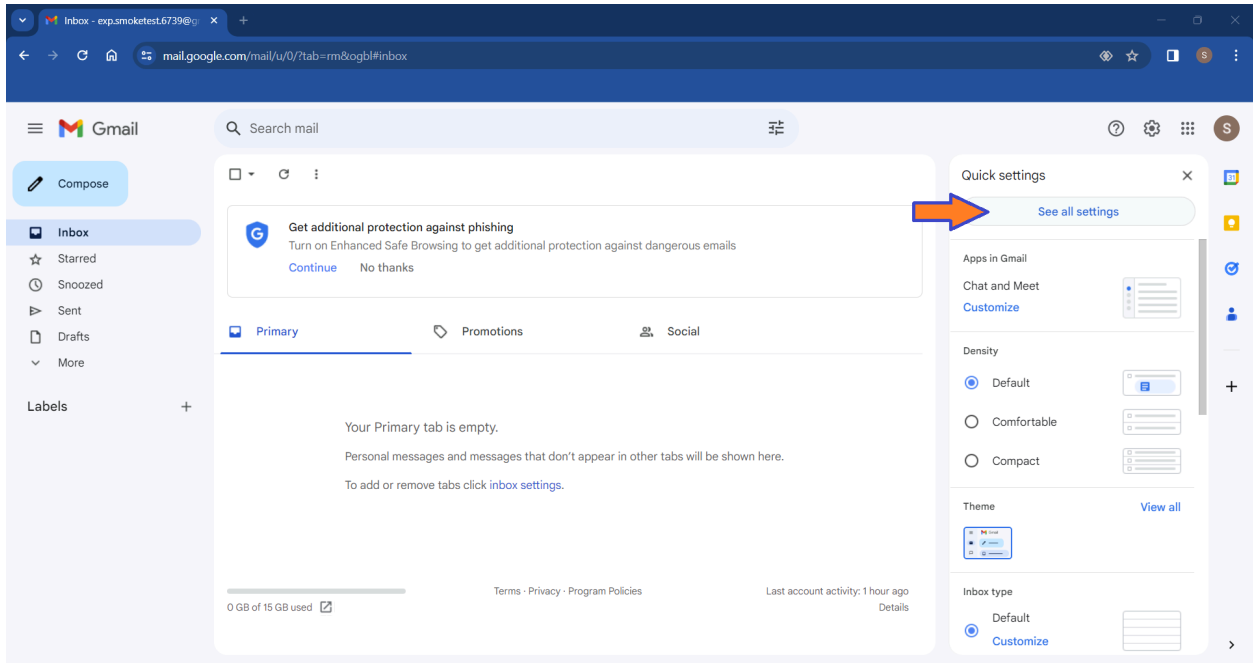
### Step 1 - Gmail

Login to your gmail.com account.

### Step 2 - Gmail

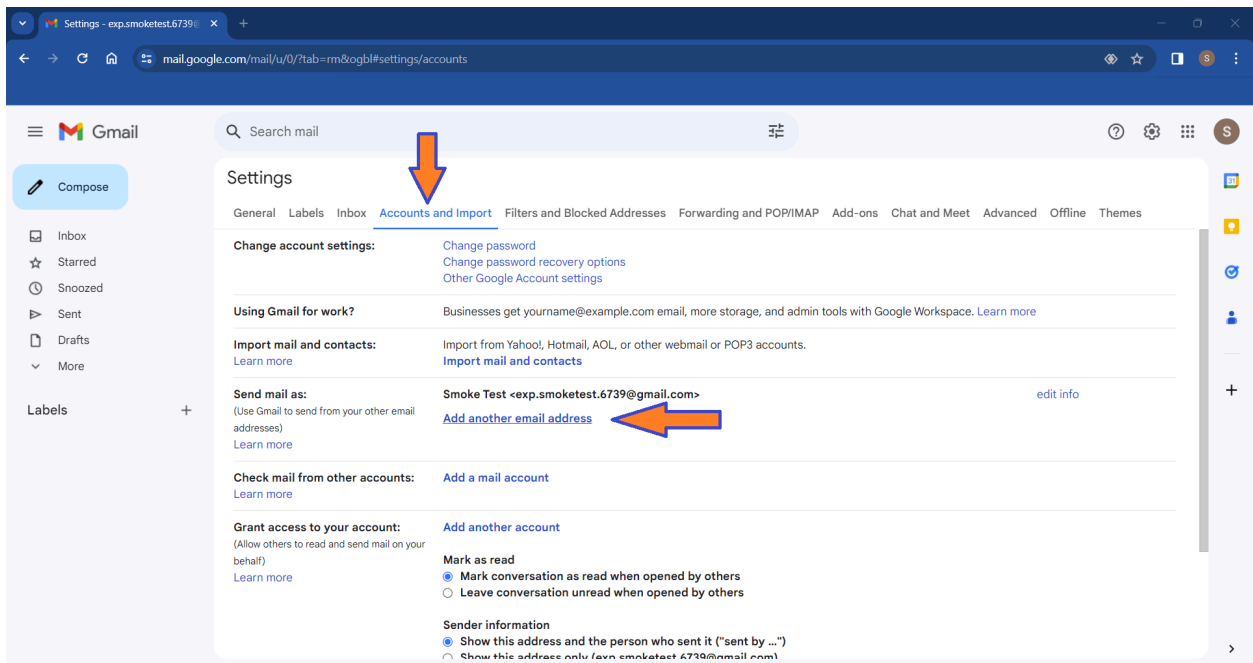
Click on the gear icon at the top right and then click on **Settings** in the drop-down.





## Step 4 - Gmail

Click on **Accounts and Import** and then click on the **Add another email address** in the section labeled **Send mail as**:



## Step 5 - Gmail

Your first and last name should be in the first box. Enter your exprealty.com email address in the second box. Click Next Step.



Make sure the Treat as an Alias box is checked.

## Step 6 - Gmail

You will enter in **outbound.ore.mailhop.org** into the SMTP Server box.  
Make sure the "Username" field contains your full email address.

The password will be the mail server password which is **expKzgGNMZupa**

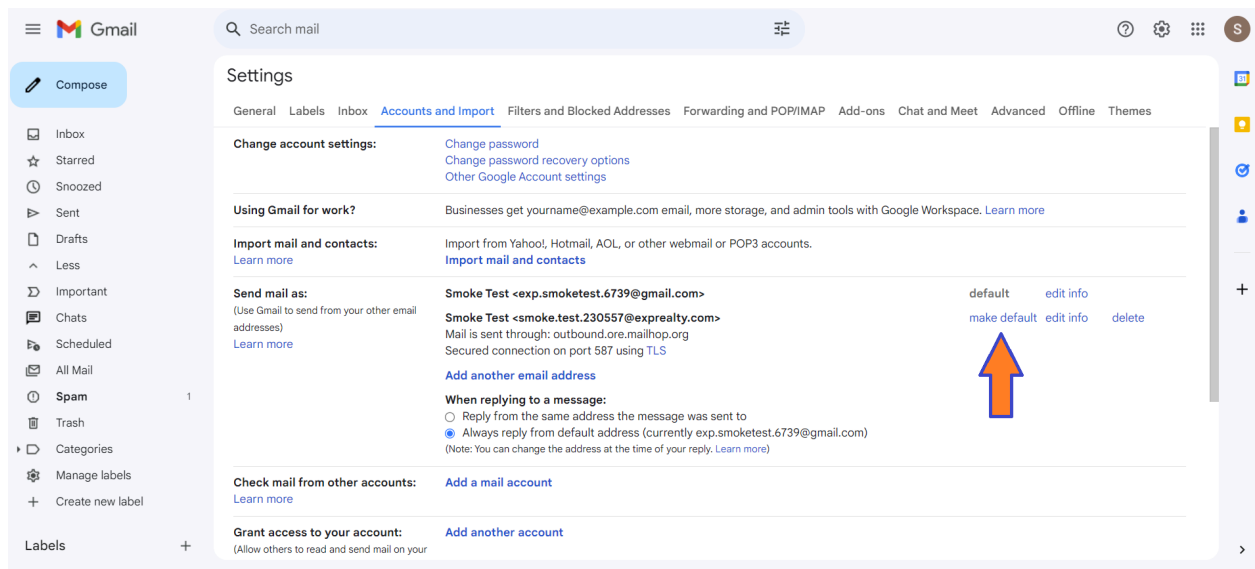
## Step 8 - Gmail

## Step 9 - Gmail

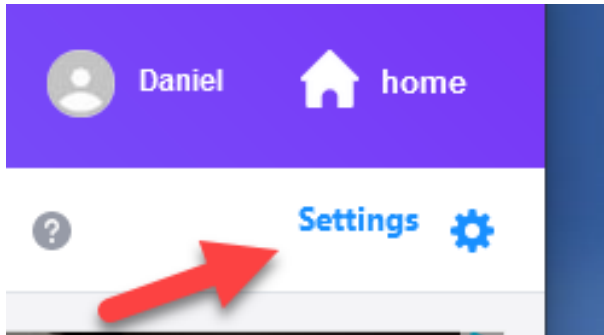
If they want to default always to exp, Click on Gear, see all settings, Import, send mail as tab. It will list both emails, beside the eXp email click on default.



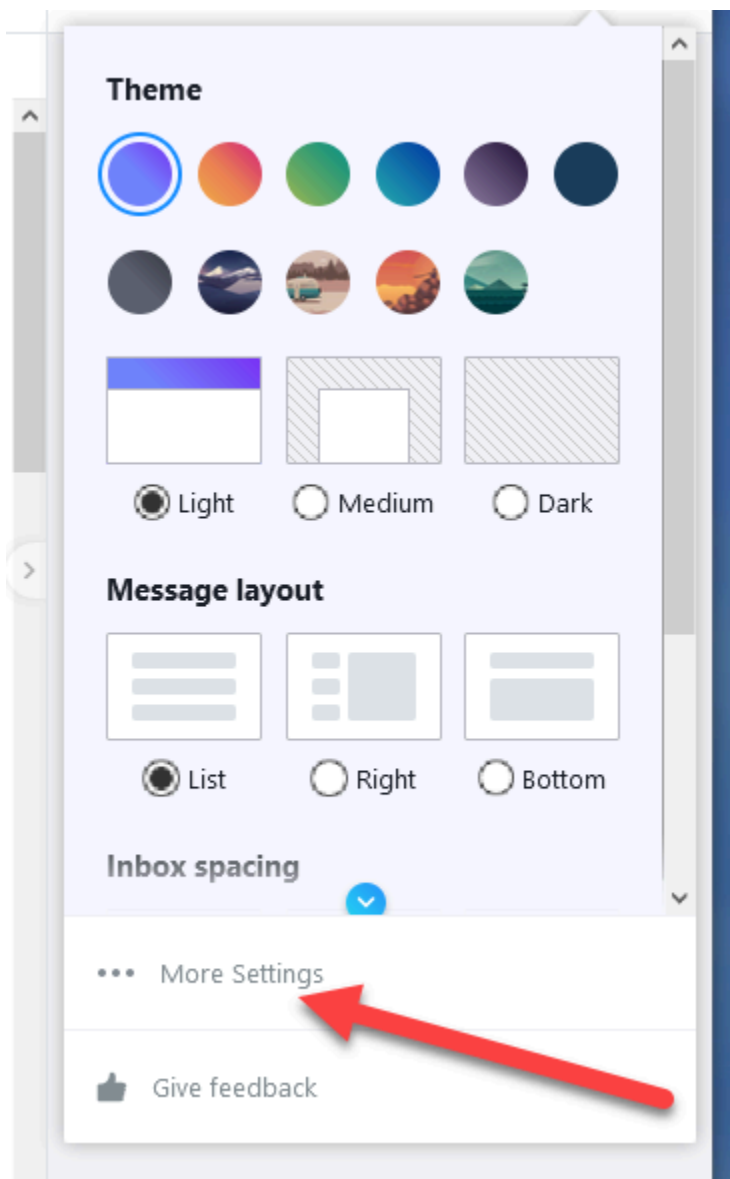
# Step 1 - Yahoo

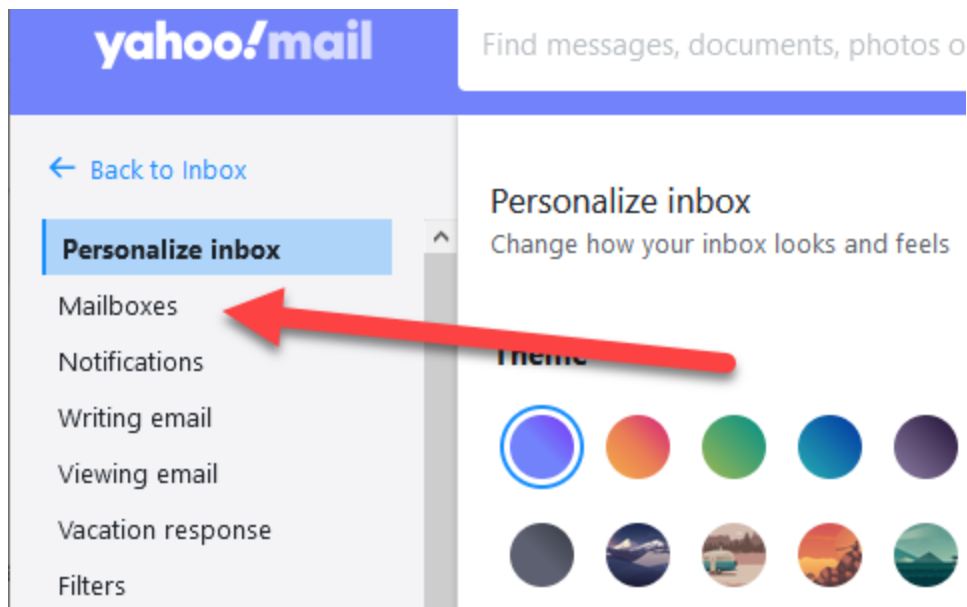
Start by opening your Yahoo mail account

- Click the Settings icon Image of the Settings icon.

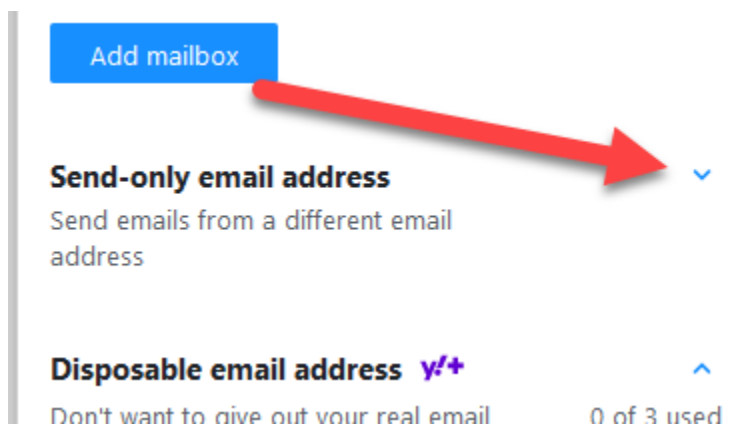


- Click More Settings

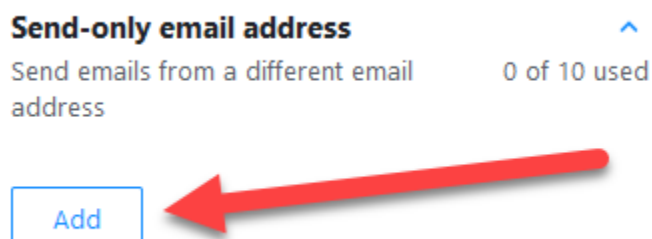




- Click the More icon More options icon next to "Send-only email address."






## Step 2 - Yahoo
