

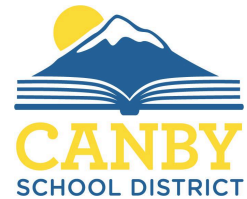

 - A. **Public Comment Guidelines**

The Canby School District Board of Education highly values public input in making important decisions that affect Canby's children and community. To ensure the public has an opportunity to offer comments during School Board meetings and to ensure that the Board can conduct the important business of the District, speakers must observe certain basic rules of conduct.

The following guidelines apply:

 - i. All members of the public attending School Board meetings, virtually or in person, must treat each other and the Board with respect.
 - ii. Individuals are not permitted to engage in conduct that interferes with the ability of other individuals to watch the Board meetings, interferes with the ability of other members of the public to offer comment to the Board, or interferes with the ability of the Board to conduct its business.
 - iii. The public may offer objective criticism of school operations and programs, but the Board will not hear complaints concerning specific school personnel or other authorized individuals. Complaints of this nature shall be addressed through the Public Complaints Policy KL-AR.

- iv. Priority is given first to students, second to Canby School District residents, and, if time allows, to non-Canby School District residents.
- v. Any person invited by the Board chair to speak to the Board at a meeting should state their name, whether they are a resident of Canby School District, and if speaking for an organization, the name and identity of the organization. A group of people with a common purpose should designate a spokesperson to speak for the group.
- vi. Generally, the time allotted for public comments is 20 minutes, and individuals will have up to three minutes to speak. At the discretion of the Board chair, further public comment may be allowed.
- vii. **If you wish to sign up to speak, email this form in [English](#) or [Spanish](#) to the Board Secretary at kamela.davis@canby.k12.or.us by noon on September 22.**

The purpose of public comment is for members of our Board of Directors to hear public concerns, comments, and opinions. Board members will not respond to public comments.
