
PFC Clifford H. Helstrom

Clifford H. Helstrom, age 94, of Wautoma, formerly of Oshkosh and Deming, NM, passed away Friday, November 6, 2009 at Heartland House, CBRF in Wautoma.

He was born December 27, 1914 in Wausau, the son of Daniel and Ella (Rosenau) Helstrom. Mr. Helstrom grew up in Oshkosh where he met and married Lorraine Ann Jensen on June 21, 1938.
