Establishing Regional Independence in the Arab World

The United Nations Security Council,,

Grieved by the recent rise of Islamophobia and Anti-Arab movements around the globe,

Deeply concerned about the numerous ongoing wars and conflicts that take place in the Middle East and Northern Africa,

Taking into consideration the cultural differences between the Asian countries of the Pacific Ocean and those of the Middle East,

Remembering the historical impact of the Arab people on the course of humanity as a whole,

- 1. *Proposes* the creation of a United Nations Middle East and North Africa Bloc, in order to assure the region's independence and sovereignty on the global scale,
- 2. *Declares* elections in the newly founded Bloc to choose a new Bloc President, Vice President and the representative for the one Security Council seat the Bloc will hold,

- 3. *Requests* that the following member states (: Algeria, Bahrain, Comoros, Djibouti, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Mauritania, Morocco, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Tunisia, U.A.E., Yemen, Eritrea, South Sudan, Iran, Turkey) and the observer state of Palestine leave their respective Blocs and join the one created by this resolution,
- 4. *Removes* one Security Council seat from the Asian Bloc to help achieve balance and equality for all UN members,
- 5. *Ensures* that all aforementioned sovereign states cooperate with each other peacefully and solve the ongoing issues that threaten the very existence of the region,
- 6. *Establishes* that the changes proposed will take place at the beginning of the next session after the one during which this resolution is debated on,
- 7. Decides to remain seized of the matter
