ROLE INFORMATION

Nemo - A young, adventurous clownfish with a "lucky fin". He's eager to explore but also faces challenges and learns about courage and self-advocacy.

Marlin - Nemo's overprotective father, who learns to trust and face the ocean's unpredictability.

Dory - An optimistic blue tang with short-term memory loss who is a key companion to Marlin on his journey.

Professor Ray - An enthusiastic stingray who is Nemo's teacher and encourages curiosity and bravery.

Pearl- A friendly flapjack octopus who becomes friends with Nemo

Sheldon - A mischievous sea horse who dares Nemo to swim beyond the reef.

Tad - A butterflyfish who joins Sheldon in encouraging Nemo to break the rules.

Bloat - A blowfish in the "Tank Gang" who keeps spirits high.

Bubbles - A yellow tang obsessed with bubbles

Gurgle- Another member of the "Tank Gang".

Peach - Another member of the "Tank Gang".

Gill - Another member of the "Tank Gang".

Nigel, Sprit, Tiller & Jib - A knowledgeable pod of pelicans, are the show's helpful narrators. These informative birds are responsible for conveying important plot points.

Bruce - An intimidating great white shark, is the sharks' ringleader. Despite Bruce's best efforts to adopt a vegetarian diet, Bruce loses control and is sent into a frenzy, threatening to devour every fish in sight. Part of the Sharks.

Chum & Anchor-Two of Bruce's shark friends try to live vegetarian lifestyles but are eventually forced to restrain Bruce from eating innocent fish. Part of The Sharks

Crush - 150 year old sea turtle who knows how to hang loose, teaches Marlin a thing or two about being a good parent.

Squirt - off spring of Crush, fearlessly twirls through turbulent waters of the ocean and enjoys trying out cool new moves in the high speed EAC.

Kai & Breeze- each have individual singing solos in “go with the flow”

Ensemble - Sea Chorus, Reef Kids, Reef Parents, Scuba Mask Dancers, Fish Friends, Seagulls, Sea Turtles & Sea Turtle Kids
