The Ambassador

- Reports to the Vice President Education
- Appointed annually to be a member of the Executive Board by the Alliance member Sarasota County Youth Development organization.
- Responsible for representing the views and interest of youth on the Board of Directors.
- Ensure money handling procedures established by SCAS Treasurer are followed, including notification of the President and Treasurer of all membership transactions.

- Responsible for submission of articles about youth interests and events for publication on SCAS web and social media sites, general media distribution and the SCAS newsletter.
- Portfolio of responsibilities includes:
 - 1. Becoming knowledgeable about how not-for-profit Boards function;
 - 2. Bringing forward opportunities for SCAS involvement in youth initiatives;
 - Carrying through on projects assigned by the Board, with the view to increasing awareness and expertise in aspects of not-for-profit management.
 - 4. Being project manager for use of SCAS Facebook & Twitter outreach to youth in the Cultural Coast and our sister cities, in coordination with the VPs for Communications. Education and Membership.
