

The Publishing Working Group recently released 3 FPWDs:

We are seeking feedback on the open issues in the documents and several new open issues. We are eager to see early experiments with these concepts and to hear about why these will or will not work, and whether the direction the Working Group has taken fits well the Open Web Platform in general. Are we on a path for creating a new type of document collection that can be expected to get traction on the Web?
