### **All student attendees must register with StriveScan:**

- StriveScan is the exclusive provider of student scanning for New Jersey college fairs. Students can register by [clicking here](#) and select “Hunterdon County College Fair”. It takes about one minute! This will allow students to easily share your information at the fair by holding up your phone with the personal barcode. You will be texted and emailed that barcode right away so that colleges can scan it. StriveScan had excellent reviews at previous fairs!
- Following the fair, you will receive a report with information on the colleges you scanned with - students love this feature!



### **Tips to prepare for the college fair:**

- Review the list of colleges attending and their location to plan your route. Locations will be added to the list just before the fair. Visit the colleges you are most interested in (expect a wait at some tables) and make an effort to visit with a few that are new to you. You never know what you’ll find!
- Consider the questions that are most important to you. Are you curious about majors, athletics, student organizations, admission process, or financial aid? Think about asking questions that can’t be answered by visiting the college website. See more questions below.
- Always be prepared with your **StriveScan** barcode, an introduction of your name and grade, and questions. Pick up materials, enjoy your conversation and learning experience, and move on to the next table.

### **At the fair:**

- **Please do not enter the fair area (Commons and nearby hallways) until 6:30 pm.** Our staff will help manage the entry area so our visiting college representatives have ample time to set up and prepare for the fair.
- When you enter the Commons, pick up a bag for materials and a list of colleges.
- Look for our “College Fair Staff” (NHS volunteers) in **red shirts** or staff members if you have questions.
- Visit the Commons to see our test prep and tutoring center representatives.
- The fair will end promptly at 8:30 pm.
- Parents are welcome to attend our fair with their students but all students are encouraged to approach the tables to begin conversations. Here are some great questions to ask when you approach the table:
  - Is your school test optional or do you require test scores?
  - Can you share the academic profile of recently admitted students?
  - What are some of the unique or popular majors offered at your school?
  - What are some of your new majors?
  - How will your college help me if I am undecided?
  - What are some of the most popular student organizations at your school?
  - How do you help freshmen transition into college?
  - What are the hot topics on campus?
  - How would you describe your student body?
